Re: COVID Quarantine Summary

Dear Congressman Hudson:

On July 10, 2020 you contacted my office to discuss notification that a person you had contact with on July 9, 2020 tested positive for SARS-CoV-2. Although you were asymptomatic at the time, further evaluation revealed you met the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) criteria for close contact to a COVID-19 patient. Per CDC guidelines, you were recommended to quarantine for 14 days starting from your last known contact date of July 9, 2020.

Due to your close contact, my office conducted a SARS-CoV-2 RT-PCR test on July 13, 2020 and a negative result was reported the same day. With this negative test and in the absence of any symptoms or additional close contacts over the 14 day period, you were able to complete a 14-day quarantine period without complication. Your quarantine status ended on July 23, 2020.
